# City & Guilds **Level 2** **Certificate in Design & Craft**

## What does the course involve?

This is a level 2 City & Guilds qualification which will take one year to complete.

This course will provide the practical skills and knowledge to design and make two assessed stitched items using the student's original ideas. Students will also produce a portfolio of hand and machine stitched samples in patchwork, appliqué and quilting.

Using a range of materials and mediums students will be introduced to the basic elements of design (line, shape, form, texture and colour) in order to understand the visual implications of the design process.

In order to get the most out of the course, students should be prepared to spend time in further study, experimenting and completing work at home. Students will also be encouraged to attend relevant exhibitions, museums and shows.

## Who is it suitable for?

This course is suitable for those beginning in patchwork and quilting, or those who already have a knowledge of techniques but wish to develop a more individual method of working.

## How does assessment take place?

- Tutorials and feedback on a weekly basis from the tutors.
- Formal assessment of completed set work by the tutors.
- Internal and external verification by City & Guilds.
- Following satisfactory completion of the course, certificates recognising competence in both design and craft are awarded by City & Guilds.

## Who are the tutors?

Hazel Ryder and Terry Donaldson are both City & Guilds qualified with wide experience of teaching patchwork, quilting and design at all levels. Both are active members of the Quilters' Guild of the British Isles and local groups.

Hazel is a prolific quilter who has had work exhibited in the UK, where she has won national awards, and in Tokyo. She is particularly interested in traditional wholecloth quilting designs, which she incorporates into her art quilts.

Terry is a member of the successful group The Stitch Witches and has exhibited locally with them. Her work made in response to their challenges and individually has also been exhibited nationally and won national awards.

## What equipment is needed?

- Basic sewing kit
- Rotary cutting equipment
- Sewing machine
- Fabric and threads
- Basic art equipment

Extra equipment and materials will be needed throughout the course, and a comprehensive list will be provided for each lesson.
